T20: Cable Drums – Damage during transport, losses, leasing and handling

### ■ Transport damage

#### We choose our transport service providers carefully.

However, please always inspect delivered goods, whatever they may be, with regard to:

- any external signs of damage,

- whether delivery was complete.

If you detect any of these faults, please have this confirmed on your shipping documents by the freight carrier before acceptance of the goods. You should also always note down the faults on the freight carrier's delivery slip.

If you fail to write down an obvious fault on the shipping documents, we shall no longer be legally held liable for any damage claims.

In the event of damage, you should also contact your local sales representative at our company and notify us of the delivery note number and/ or invoice number.

If you detect a hidden fault, please promptly notify your relevant sales representative.
